- All Library users shall report to the Librarian on the first visit and shall complete Library Registration
- Access to electronic resources, collections and information platforms shall be available on CGH ICT and on personal devices using credentialed login
- All Library users shall be familiar with CGH Use of Information & Communication Technologies
